

# Decode UTF-8 & Base64 Mail Subject

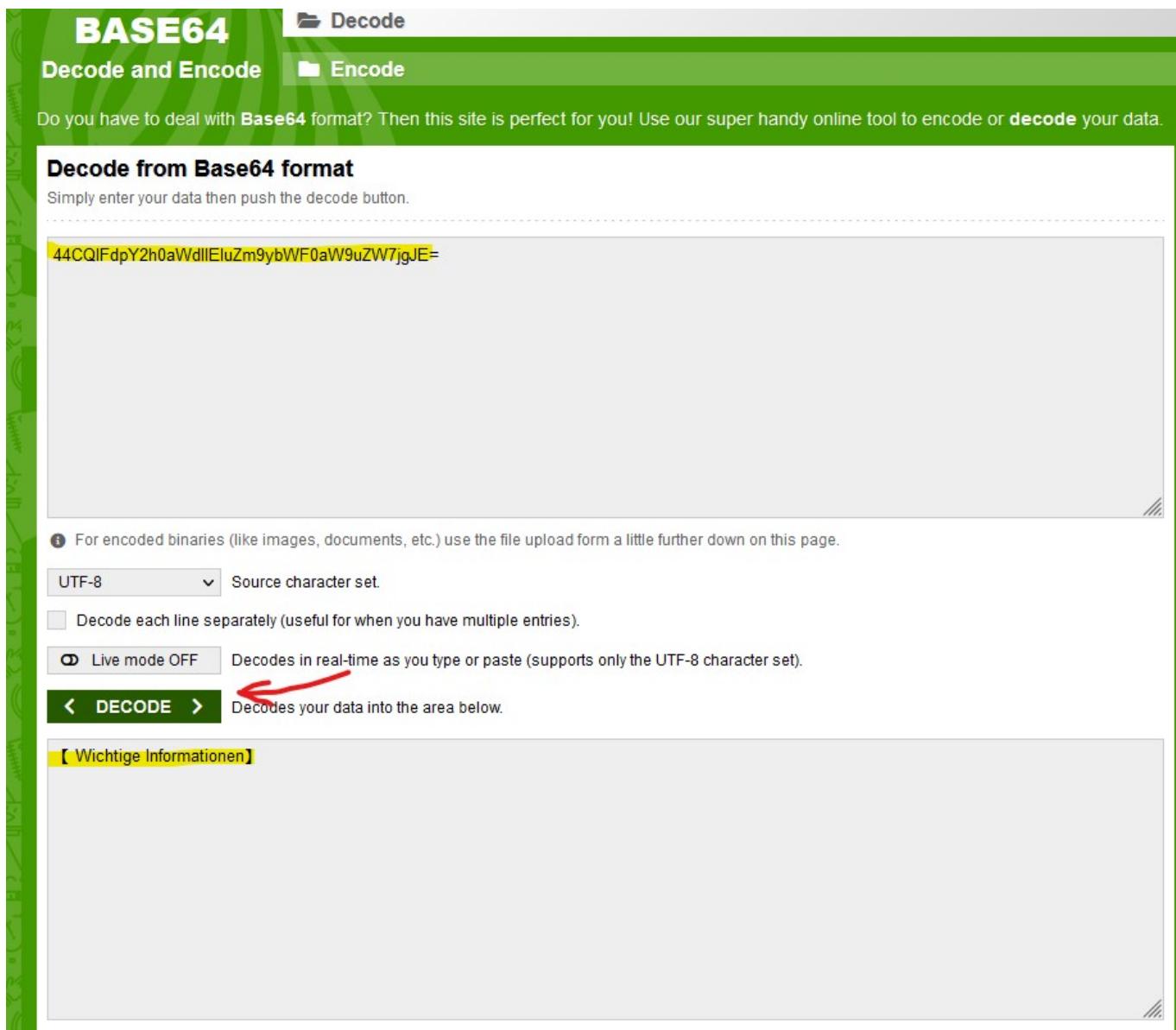
Input:

```
Subject:=?utf-8?B?44CQIFdpY2h0aWd1IEluZm9ybWF0aW9uZW7jgJE=?=
```

Take the string from the 2nd "?" to the last "?" - in this case

```
44CQIFdpY2h0aWd1IEluZm9ybWF0aW9uZW7jgJE=
```

and paste it into <https://www.base64decode.org/> - Hit Decode
