

Install XRDP and XFCE

1. Install XFCE & XRDP

```
sudo apt-get -y install xrdp xfce4
```

2. Fix Policy Kit to Avoid Color Manager Error Message

```
cat << EOF | sudo tee /etc/polkit-1/localauthority.conf.d/02-allow-color.conf
polkit.addRule(function(action, subject) {
    if ((action.id == "org.freedesktop.color-manager.create-device" ||
action.id == "org.freedesktop.color-manager.create-profile" ||
action.id == "org.freedesktop.color-manager.delete-device" || action.id
== "org.freedesktop.color-manager.delete-profile" || action.id ==
"org.freedesktop.color-manager.modify-device" || action.id ==
"org.freedesktop.color-manager.modify-profile") &&
subject.isInGroup("{group}")) {
        return polkit.Result.YES;
    }
});
EOF
```

3. Create default file .xsession for new users

```
echo xfce4-session | sudo tee /etc/skel/.xsession
```

4. Do not start GUI on console

```
sudo systemctl set-default multi-user.target
```

5. Reboot to provide clean start

```
sudo reboot
```
